### **#iGiveCatholic Giving Day Takes Place in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia on #GivingTuesday**

*Archdiocese of Philadelphia and The Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia partnered to support this national Catholic Day of Giving.*

**PHILADELPHIA, December 1, 2020** – The Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia (CFGP) partnered with the Archdiocese of Philadelphia to participate in #iGiveCatholic for the first time. Today is the official #iGiveCatholic Giving Day.

#iGiveCatholic is celebrated annually on #GivingTuesday, which follows Thanksgiving, Black Friday, and Cyber Monday. #iGiveCatholic is a Giving Day that kicks off the charitable season and brings the Catholic community together to give thanks and give back. For 2020, the Archdiocese of Philadelphia joined CFGP in promoting this special, faith-based giving day, with support from

Archbishop Nelson J. Pérez, Archbishop of Philadelphia.

“We are kicking off an amazing initiative in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia! #iGiveCatholic celebrates the beauty of our faith, demonstrates our shared commitment to live out the Corporal Works of Mercy, and inspires acts of Christian charity,” said Archbishop Pérez.

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia’s participation in #iGiveCatholic presents an opportunity for Catholics to affirm their faith as disciples of Jesus Christ by sharing their gifts out of love for God and one another. It also gives parishes, schools, and nonprofit organizations the chance to rally support for their individual ministries and make a difference in their community, with the goal of raising as many funds as possible for these important missions. In this first year of participation, over 100 Archdiocesan organizations registered to participate.

Giving towards the #iGiveCatholic initiative will remain open until midnight tonight.
