Martha's Choice growing with generous grant



"The farm and the market bring clients, volunteers, and neighbors together intentionally to feed both body and spirit," said Patrick Walsh, Director of Programs at Martha's Choice.

Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm, the largest food pantry in Montgomery County, recently received a large grant from the Connelly Foundation to continue expanding their community-building work. In 2021, Martha's Choice distributed 1.5 million pounds of food to almost 10,000 households! About 5,000 pounds of that food was freshly harvested from Martha's Community Farm in Audubon.

Your support of CSS and Martha's Choice Marketplace and Community Farm is so important to our mission of providing food and a sense of community for people who need it. Many families suffered with food insecurity throughout the pandemic, but
